#### **School Ethos**

We are an inclusive Catholic school in the diocese of Cashel and Emly. In co-operation with Fr. ### **Policy Development**

Policies worked on and reviewed by the BoM this year include: School Self Evaluation Plan (2018 -2020), GDPR Audit, Admissions Policy (Approved by Patron), Digital Learning Plan and Critical Incident Policy. In-school procedures are reviewed regularly throughout the year.

## Forbairt

Forbairt is a programme for a school leadership team, comprising of the principal and deputy principal. It is constructed on an action learning model which is designed to support school leaders to explore leadership in their context. H. Jordan and T. Hickey participated in the Forbairt initiative this year and led a project entitled, "Leading Improved Proficiency in and Attitudes towards Oral Irish in our Whole School."

### **Curricular Development**

School Self-Evaluation focussed on the use of oral Irish as a means of general communication throughout the school. Literacy Lift Off was continued for junior pupils and graded reading continued for seniors. Team teaching was incorporated in both classrooms focussing on maths. Additionally, team teaching was employed in the senior room for novel and persuasive writing and in the junior room for literacy and oral language development. Our graded approach to the teaching of spellings was introduced. In relation to well-being, the Friends for Life Programme was implemented with 3rd and 4th class pupils, whilst "Feel Good Friday" was also implemented in the senior room. Teacher CPD took place in relation to Irish, the New Language Curriculum, New Child Protection Inspection Model, Team Teaching and Differentiation, PE, Art and Leadership.
